RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

- 1. An eligible applicant for a First Catholic Slovak Ladies Association Fraternal Scholarship Award must meet the following qualifications:
 - a. A member in good standing with the Association for a minimum of three years prior to date of application. The applicant must also hold one of the following policies in their own name: a permanent life insurance policy with a face amount of at least \$1,000; a term insurance policy with a minimum coverage of \$5,000; or an annuity certificate. Membership eligibility and policy requirements will be verified by the Home Office records.
 - b. **Members currently enrolled in Z-Branches**, formerly known as Polish Women's Alliance of America (PWAA) who meet all other eligibility criteria may apply for any available scholarships.
 - c. Undergraduate applicants must select an accredited college or university <u>in the United States</u> and be enrolled full-time, at least 12 credit hours, in a program leading to an associate or bachelor's degree. Postgraduate applicants must be enrolled full-time for at least 9 credit hours in an accredited college or university in the United States.
 - d. **Applicants may receive only one scholarship per category.** If you have already been awarded an undergraduate scholarship, you are not eligible to apply for an additional undergraduate award. However, if you previously received an undergraduate scholarship and are now enrolled in post-graduate school, you may apply for a post-graduate level scholarship. *Important Note: Recipients of a Vocational/Technical/Trade Scholarship are not eligible to apply for a College Scholarship.*
 - e. **Use of Funds:** The award must be applied toward **school-related expenses** for the academic year for which it was awarded. Eligible costs include tuition, books, fees, and course- or degree-specific expenses, such as required supplies or equipment.

2. Application requirements:

- a. **Freshman applicants:** Submit an <u>official</u> high school transcript, including the most recent grading period, along with scores from any college entrance examination board tests (ex: ACT, SAT). If you are undecided about your school choice, place a check mark on the last page of the application just below the "Name and Address of College or University" field. A letter of acceptance—on the college's official letterhead—must be received by the Scholarship Department before any scholarship payment will be issued.
- b. **College and Post-Graduate Applicants:** Submit your most recent <u>official</u> college or university transcript. If preferred, your school may send an official copy directly via postal mail or email—please indicate this choice on your application.
- c. **Autobiographical Statement:** Submit an autobiographical statement of approximately 500 words outlining your goals and objectives. The statement must also address the following:
 - Describe any leadership skills you have demonstrated.
 - Include one paragraph about your involvement in school activities.
 - Include another paragraph detailing your church or community service. Was your service voluntary or mandatory?

- d. Letter of recommendation: Include one letter of recommendation from someone other than a family member.
- e. Photo Submission: Include a wallet-sized photo (optional). It must be either:
 - a printed photo on photo paper: or
 - a .jpg attachment submitted electronically. Note: Photos must be of good quality to be eligible for publication.
- f. Submission Deadline: All applications and supporting documents must be POSTMARKED or electronically received by Tuesday, February 10, 2026. Late submissions will not be considered. Materials submitted will not be returned.

- 4. Selection and Award Process: The final decision will be made by an independent Judging Committee composed of professionals in the education field. Scholarship recipients will be notified by letter during the 2nd week in May 2026. The names of all winners will be published in the August issue of "Fraternally Yours." Award checks will be issued on or about July 1st in the name of the college or university and in the name of the student.
